### Role & Guidelines for C3 Church Queenstown

**About the role:** Operating the sound desk for our services and events is a position of great importance; you are part of creating and curating a flowing, balanced sounding experience for the people in attendance. While prioritising organisation and flow is important, flexibility and a can do, team player attitude is just as important. You are helping as part of an awesome team, working closely with the Service Overseer on the day, coordinating with the Audio Visual person, Worship Leader and Service Leaders MCing the service, all to help curate an experience for people to worship and connect with the Holy Spirit, all so they can know Jesus more and find community together as we gather.

**Overseen by - on Sunday's:** Service Overseers in conjunction with Lead Pastors.

**Caring for you:** as a valued member of our Church team and family, our heart for you is that you continue to grow in knowing Jesus and find community through our Sunday service and mid-week dinner parties. As part of completing the Next Step pathway you will have:

- Made the decision to make C3 your Home Church.
- Completed the Next Step Google Form after completing Step 4
- Join a Dinner Party and plan to regularly attend; dinner parties are the place for you to find community in your Church and where you can bring friends along. C3 Dinner Party Hosts are also responsible for your pastoral care; meaning they are there for you, to pray with you and to encourage you in your faith journey.
- You're part of the Dream Team now...exciting! We regularly get all the volunteers across our whole Church together for a night called ALL IN Dream Team. These nights are fun and create valuable connections for you as part of the team. We have supper, connect, worship, pray, have fun and hear Ps Andrew and Alana's hearts for the coming season, so we can be on the same page as a Church, building the Kingdom together for God's glory.
- Relationships are highly valued at C3, we love to keep communication open and honest and we love to do life well together, so catching up and checking in is a normal part of our culture and we encourage you to connect with your team leader and team regularly for fun and feedback.

### Required Experience:

- Great communication skills
- A great ear for music and what sounds good and bad.
- Proficient in the workings of sound equipment
- Proficient in working with audio devices
- An eye for detail
- Great team player, can do attitude
- Knowledge of worship songs and music arrangements is important

### Role timeframe and time commitment:

- Sundays from 9am with the worship team, until approx 12.45pm, when morning tea has finished and there is no longer a need for background music or AV.
- In 2021 attend the fortnightly worship team practice with the sound team at Church; this time is for training and preparing for Sundays.

### Responsibilities

9am Before the Service:

- Set up, plug in and turn on the desk
- Connect HDMI / Aux to the sound desk

- Sound check and run through while the worship team is practicing.

9.45am

- Check in with the service overseer and Av's, double check and go over the runsheet.

10.00am

- Pre Service prayer and free worship - feel free to join in at your post.
- If the band EVER needs to stop playing for some reason, always put on background music.

10.30am

- As the service moves through the runsheet, please ensure that the sound is on point for each part of the service.
- Sometimes when someone is praying and they really start feeling the holy spirit move, adjust the sound accordingly; sound up for zeal and vigor, sound down for stillness and peace.
- When running a video, please make sure the sound is turned up relatively loudly, as soon as it starts to play.

As the service concludes:

- Coordinate with the transition of worship team to background music, this is primarily by eye contact with the worship leader or on the indication of the service leader or overseer.
- Please play background music from the C3NYC Radio playlist on Spotify during morning tea.
- Please enjoy time connecting and having a hot drink and some morning tea.
- Pack up is to be no earlier than 12.45pm please and 1.30pm on Funday Sunday Services, where we prioritise and value connection and community, we don't want people enjoying connecting together and the music and AV shut downs too soon.
