SUNDAY - YOUR HEART

2 Chronicles 16:9 For the eyes of the LORD range throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him.

ABIDE IN HIM - John 15:1-17

Make spending time reading the word, in worship and prayer the priority of your life. Declare Jesus is your Lord and Saviour and your complete dependence on God. Ask for a renewed passion for His presence and fresh revelation of His Word.
